skills could be put into practice.

The `wānanga series was face to face with our pakeke supported by their tamariki so that we could give them the knowledge, skills and support to be able to access the internet, as this moving forward would be our main communication vehicle.

The first ever Whangara Farms Podcast series (5 x 30 minute episodes) was broadcast weekly covering our history and journey to date. This was to appeal to all generations and now our pakeke had the support to do so. This also had immediate impact to gain online engagement following the wānanga. Wānanga and podcasts are now a permanent part of our annual schedule of events and at the forefront of our Communications and Engagement Strategy.

What are the outcomes of this project? *

We have been able to reach shareholders and whānau globally, and even locally where pakeke are unable to travel. This will be critical with climate change.

We have a communications strategy that appeals to all age groups. We now have a Communications Specialist who will develop our website to be more interactive, and be present on social media platforms that appeal to all ages. For example TikTok for our Tane, FaceBook for our 30 to 90 ages, Snapchat, Instagram, Spotify, YouTube, Linkedin (careers and collaborations).
