Introduction

This first quarterly report against the 2017/18 Activity Plan accounts for our continued efforts to the end of the 1st Quarter, 30 June 2017.

Points of note include the following.

- 1. In our Security and Trust focus area, the Issues team releasing two documents on encryption; the first explains what encryption is, how it is used across the Internet, how it is used for good and how it is used for bad. The second sets out what InternetNZ thinks New Zealand needs to do in order to front foot this issue and not get left behind. These documents have been described by the National Business Review as "required reading" and have been quite timely given the decision of the Australian Government to move on limits to encryption.
- 2. We've been doing preparatory work for the review of the Copyright Act in the **Creative Use** focus area, working with others to develop our thinking about Internet-friendly copyright law.
- 3. In our **Access** focus area, the release of a new Telecommunications Bill to progress the reform of that legislation is not likely until after the General Election.
- 4. The **State of the Internet report** is in the development and planning phase, with publication due later in the year.
- 5. Preparations for NetHui 2017 are well under way, to be held in Auckland in November.
- 6. A **Community Grants** round is under way, with Projects and Conference Attendance the focus. The next round is at the end of the year, focused on Internet Research.
- 7. Our Operations team is busy planning this year's AGM, due at the end of July.
- 8. Council is progressing the **Organisational Review** that is taking a look at how we organise our work across the InternetNZ group.
