Introduction

This second quarterly report against the 2017/18 Activity Plan accounts for our continued efforts to the end of September 2017.

InternetNZ has been undertaking an Organisational Review during 2017. In this second quarter, some activities have been deferred or delayed due to the impact of that review - primarily activities that might presuppose a particular way of organising the work of the group. Points of note in this quarter include the following.

- 1. A big focus has been on preparation for **NetHui 2017**, being held in Auckland 9-10 November at the Aotea Centre. The programme is out and registrations are picking up: <u>www.NetHui.nz</u> for more.
- 2. With a **General Election** held during the quarter (without Internet policy being central to the debate), we monitored party policies and have been preparing briefings to incoming Ministers once these are known.
- 3. In our **Access** focus area, the release of a new Telecommunications Bill provided an early opportunity to develop our submissions, since they are not called for before the election.
- 4. In **Creative Use** we appreciated the release of the Government's terms of reference for a review of the Copyright Act late in Q1, starting with an issues paper intended for February 2018. This has given some helpful early focus to our policy work in this area.
- 5. The **State of the Internet report** progressed in the quarter, and is due for release in November.
- 6. A **Community Grants** round was conducted during the quarter, with Projects and Conference Attendance the focus. Decisions on both are due in October. The next round is in December.
- 7. Our **Operations** team successfully carried out the 2017 AGM and elections with good attendance and a great chance to mix and mingle.
- 8. Thanks to **Hayden Glass** and **Rochelle Furneaux** for their service to InternetNZ on the Council to this year's AGM, and congratulations to newly elected Councillors **Kate Pearce** and **Don Stokes**, joining returning Councillors **Sarah Lee** and **Dave Moskovitz** for the 2017-2020 term.
- 9. We farewelled a number of staff in this quarter (Laura, Megan and Sarah), to maternity leave or for adventures in the provinces. Significantly, we have a new Communications Team as of end of September, with Acting Manager Sue McCarty on contract covering Megan Baker, and Henry Williams seconded as Communications Advisor from the Domain Name Commission.
- 10. Council is progressing the **Organisational Review** with final decisions on our future operating structure likely in October.
