Learning has been applied to:

- 1) Development of new makerspace at Kapiti Coast District Libraries (learning from Stirling makerspace which had just won a Scottish innovation award)
- 2) Looking at new programmes to be included in community training sessions e.g. rise of fake news and how to recognise it online (big focus for Cologne libraries)
- 3) Exploring model from Tilburg of creating 'labs' that allow informal community learning and participation (they have six - gaming, maker, time, word, food, future) and how technology can both support and enhance the experience)
- 4) Tweaked the tech setup in our new community connector van which is currently been fitted out to allow more flexible learning (lessons from Stirling libraries)
- 5) Sharing the importance of the role the library plays in breaking down digital exclusion
