Report of Factual Findings

Purpose of this Agreed-Upon Procedures Report

Our report is solely for the purpose of assisting Board in determining whether InternetNZ Incorporated comply with its constitution relating to the electoral process for the Council election for the AGM dated 31 July 2025 and may not be suitable for another purpose.

Responsibilities of the Engaging Party and the Responsible Party

The Board has acknowledged that the agreed-upon procedures are appropriate for the purpose of the engagement.

InternetNZ Incorporated, as identified by the Board, is responsible for the subject matter on which the agreed-upon procedures are performed.

Our Responsibilities

We have conducted the agreed-upon procedures engagement in accordance with the International Standard on Related Services (New Zealand) (ISRS (NZ)) 4400, *Agreed-Upon Procedures Engagements*, issued by the New Zealand Auditing and Assurance Standards Board. An agreed-upon procedures engagement involves our performing the procedures that have been agreed with the Board, and reporting the findings, which are the factual results of the agreed-upon procedures performed. We make no representation regarding the appropriateness of the agreed-upon procedures.

1.	For the available Council Member positions obtain the election results and confirm the following:	
	(a) Check that one member is elected per available position within the election timeframe.	We have confirmed that the two available positions were each filled by one member within the 15 day election timeframe. Elections opened on 14 July 2025 and closed on 29 July 2025.
	(b) Check that the highest polling candidate is elected for the prescribed term.	We have confirmed that the following two candidates received the highest polling result for the two available board member positions, Jonathan Ayling and Dylan Reeve.

I hereby declare the final result of the InternetNZ 2025 Council Election, which closed at 5pm on Tuesday 29 July 2025, as follows:

Election of TWO (2) Councillors

Total Valid Votes 2,785
Total Invalid Votes 0
Winning Threshold/Quota 929

After the tallying of all preferences, the successful candidates are Jonathan AYLING and Dylan REEVE.

The unsuccessful candidates were Douglas BROWN, Roger BROWN, Toby CUNLIFFE-STEEL, Kaye-Maree DUNN, Bianca GRIZHAR, Maureen HILYARD, Adam HUNT, Peter-Lucas JONES, Seth KENLON, Brynn NEILSON and Suzie TINGLEY.

The return percentage was 62.40% being 2,785 votes received from 4,463 members.
