What were the highlights and main takeaways of this conference?

- Running a packed workshop session on the Creative Commons Release 'em card game. Feedback was excellent! "That was awesome!" was one of the first audience comments at the end. We had to drag them away from playing they were that engaged.
- Challenge of getting 500 decks of cards through Portuguese Customs in time for the last day of the conference (they almost didn't make it!). These were highly sought after by the participants at the conference. We also found that Belgium have already remixed the cards for their local needs.
- An amazing keynote talk from Jamie Boyle from Duke University Law School about the history of musicians borrowing from each other to give us the music we have today (and how restrictive copyright reforms are breaking this!). They produced a comic book to highlight this rather than a boring academic paper! I have a hardcopy and you can also freely download this at: https://law.duke.edu/musiccomic/download/
- A thoughtful panel and discussion on Traditional Knowledge and Indigenous Data Sovereignty. Key tensions being the traditional Copyright Laws and the Public Domain don't lend themselves to the collectivist stewardship model if Traditional Knowledge artefacts. This is going to be an interesting and challenging space to watch.
- A very interesting panel of Al and copyright with reps from Google, Flickr and other big tech firms... hint, they are happy to self-regulate but no one is chasing them for it at the moment...
- Contributing to a hackathon to digitise old maps of Palestine through the https://palopenmaps.org/project.
