What were the highlights and main takeaways of this conference?

I found the keynotes especially really engaging, and was emboldened to find them bringing up cosmology-level debates about technology ownership, design, and use (especially the international keynotes Adele Vrana and Anasuya Sengupta talking about Wikipedia and their 'whose knowledge' project aimed at centring the knowledge of marginalised communities).

In regard to my own talk, I was really happy to receive some great feedback afterwards, with a few people coming up to me and remarking on their own relationship to the "Silicon Valley story" which I outlined in my presentation. I was really happy about this as this is just the reflection I was hoping to encourage. A few audience members also proposed items or made provocations relating to the 16 futures quadrant I presented (v2.0, pictured below, encompassing their reactions). Others mentioned to me that in the context of a conference which mainly presents useful and practical reports on projects, it was also good to have a thought-provoking more 'big idea' type talk.
