We have attended a workshop with SoP and regular online meetings.

We have started introducing the importance of evaluation with our 56 Learning Centres - with direct presentations, explaining the Motivation, Access, Skills and Trust methodology we are adopting.

We are developing a questionnaire which identifies the starting point for new Learning Centre members which will be followed up some three months later to identify progress or lack of it.

We are about to undertake our national roadshow to present the methodology directly to committee and volunteer tutors.

Our focus in the past has been about teaching with an internal focus - "did we teach this course well?". Now we are trying to focus externally by asking the participants "what can you do now that you didn't do before?"

We have started to look at how we attract people to our Learning Centres; the messages we use; talking about outcomes, rather than outputs. In the past we have asked people to attend "lessons" i.e. "File Management" - now we are trying to convert our Learning Centres to talk about the outcomes - "learn how to sort your photos".
