We have been supporting people to gain affordable internet through our partnership with Skinny Jump - do date we have supported 25 families and individuals. We have been receiving referrals through our connection with local community centres and social service providers and also through participants in the one on one computer skills training.

We have been providing individual computer training to people in the community - to date we have provided individual training to 26 people - we have 6 people who attend regularly - either weekly or fortnightly - these are all Māori or Pasifika women aged in their 40s and 50s who had no digital literacy. The other 20 have varied from one session to learn a particular skill such as on line banking or social media safety and vary in attendance from a single session to 4. They usually space out their sessions.

To date we have not established our refurbishment hub however we plan to have it up and running in the the new year.

What have you learnt so far? *

The participants who are attending the individual computer sessions are predominantly Māori and Pasifika women and elderly single Pakēhā men. The consistent informal feedback that been that they feel comfortable with the individual attention and skills training, all have previously taken computer courses and found them overwhelming and confusing. The additional demographic of older single men has been unexpected but on reflection is not surprising.
