Due to the time of year that we began delivery the weather was not great to bring our senior people outdoors. So worked with our senior representatives for each roopu and opted to wait for warmer weather for people to be able to come out without fear of catching cold or COVID.

We worked with Te Whanau o Waipareira Trust to deliver to Maori. Our first delivery day in September, was a group of 15 participants - 2 males and the rest females. All were computer illiterate and most dependent on family for looking after their bank accounts online and paying bills. All very excited at having a brand new chromebook with a wireless mouse, carry bag and 3 year warranty. We had two more group sessions and then broke into one on one weekly sessions - to help meet their individual needs and pace.

We worked with PIC Papatoetoe to reach our Pacifika target of 15 people and was schedule to deliver in October 2022, however the minister got called away to Samoa so our first deliver is 16 December 2022.

The remaining 10 participants aged European x 10 - we have delivered one on one, and identified them individually as they have come into our offices looking for a job or help with a CV and spoke about their interaction with technology as a mini interview to see if they met our criteria for the project and then if they did, proceeded to invite them to be a participant. All have enjoyed the one on one learning, amazed at receiving a chromebook as part of their learning and truly grateful for the patience and gift to connect them with a world they have

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shied away from.

As we are dealing with senior people we have totally worked around what they can and cannot do, even not wanting to come out in cold weather - to the patience required to help them become competent in just logging into their new device.

It has been reinforced to us that when dealing with our senior people, their needs must be taken into full consideration - in the wider sense, to be able to gain trust, and for them to feel comfortable learning without feeling stressed, or that they are a bother. Their confidence to learn without fear of making errors or forgetting things shown is grown through our calmness, consistency, patience and sincerity.

What (if anything) have you changed in your approach or practices? Explain why this was necessary?

I have changed the start dates to accommodate the people in the cold weather.

I have changed the start date for deliver to the Pasifika group due to their Minister having to go to Samoa.

We have seen that our ongoing weekly support is important to their being competent in continued daily use of their chromebook.
