## **Grant initiative update**

#### Initiative title \*

Supporting Aotearoa Rangatahi to Thrive in a Media Saturated World

## Provide a short summary of the work that was completed as part of this initiative.

This study investigated the perspectives of young people aged 12 to 18 years from minority communities in Aotearoa New Zealand on how media and technology influence their mental health and wellbeing. Adopting participatory research approaches, we conducted 19 focus groups (n=77) with young people from Māori, Pacific, Deaf, or Rainbow (LGBTQA +) communities. Thematic analysis identified six overarching themes: (1) constant device use; (2) diverse device use for distinct and related purposes; (3) positive aspects of device use; (4) negative aspects of device use; (5) young people have the solutions for young people; and (6) young people have the solutions for adults. These themes highlight the multifaceted nature of media and technology and propose practical strategies for fostering healthy media habits. As an anchor paper, this work sets a foundation for future research and policy informed by the lived experiences and solutions proposed by those most affected —young people themselves.

We have conducted 19 focus groups involving 77 young people aged 12 to 18 years from Māori, Pacific, Deaf, or Rainbow (LGBTQA+) communities. The research team are current writing up the key findings disseminating the overarching findings as well as the more

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nuanced findings. We are working with a school to look at ways in which the results of our study can be used to inform school practices and policies within the school. We are also intending on working with an animator or graphic artist to visualise the key findings of our study, to be disseminated more widely on social media platforms.
