The funding for this initiative enabled us to run our one-on-one free digital skills lessons at our local Miramar and Maupuia Community Centre. This provided local people the opportunity to gain the skills they need, and to increase the trust and confidence to use the internet. It also ensure that people feel safe participating online and to connect with others (family, businesses, Govt, health) and we ran the one on one mentoring at a pace that worked best for them. People were able to have as many one-on-one sessions as they required, and many continue to come back each week.

- We were able to provide weekly one on one mentoring for 20 people in 2023
- Many of the participants had very little knowledge of computers, internet or digital technology
- We were able to support a range of participants who need to learn how to use online forms for MSD, IRD and other social services.
- Some were interested in learning how to do online shopping, and in a safe way
- Some were interested to learn how to search for information
- We saw large increases in participants confidence using digital devices (laptop, smart phones) and also gained confidence in using some relevant apps, basic software (word, powerpoint, zoom video)

- We were happy to increase participants increase in digital literacy but also increased their knowledge of online security
- We also assisted 8 people in signed up with a Skinny Jump modem.
