Our original plan was to pilot the project in just three local authority areas; our plan now is to offer this module to all of our Stepping UP delivery partners who are engaging with seniors (expected to be at up to 50 locations by June 2021).

What have you learnt so far? *

We had hoped to launch the programme in October, but the disruptions caused by the Covid-19 lockdowns and subsequent social distancing limitations resulted in our delivery partners requesting a delay until early 2021 before taking on any new programmes.

(For research) What findings have you made so far? (For projects) Describe areas for improvement, challenges or reasons for success.

What (if anything) have you changed in your approach and practices? Why was this necessary?

We under-estimated the amount of time involved in developing the modules; the different terminology used on Apple and Android Apps has meant we are effectively having to produce 20 modules. Each module is designed to fit on double-sided A4 (folded to DL size), but this has resulted in screen shots that are too small for elderly people to read easily, so we are planning to scale these up to A3.
