Safe Digital Inclusion for CALD Community

ARMSS provided one on one support to number of clients from different ethnic backgrounds in supporting them learning and using their devices: laptops and smart phones. Then clients participated came from different ethnic groups including: Arabic, Afghani, Colombian and Burmese. The support covered wide range of topics including: create and login to Gmail accounts, IRD website and account, using Microsoft word, login to education providers websites, using smart phones, google search, create an account and login to Job Search websites and using TEAM meeting online. The delivery took place in different places according to the client's needs including: Johnsonville collective hub, ARMSS office in Johnsonville and public libraries.

ARMSS provided a workshop for youth from ethnic community on the safe use of the internet. The workshop run for over 2 hours and light lunch was provided. The workshop was delivered by a Cyber Security lecturer and specialist and covered wide range of topics including: identity theft, hacking, safe use of social media, safe use of gamine devices, safe passwords, safe use of bank cards and cyber bullying. The workshop took place in ARMSS office in Johnsonville

ARMSS will be running its final workshop for parents and adults on the 12th of May. the workshops will be run by the same facilitator and will be delivering more topics which are also more advanced and more relevant for parents as well as business owners. the workshop will run from 11:00 am - 4:00 pm and lunch will be provided.

For future funding we will focus more on one on one support for the basic training as we found it difficult for some ethnic groups members to attend workshops which might clash with their English classes or working hours as well as some families expressed hardship with child care.

What are the outcomes of this initiative? *

The participants were able to use some features on their devices which they were not aware of or were not capable of using. This has made their life easier and save them time which they previously needed to wait for someone else to come and help them. Other participants are now more capable of using Microsoft word mainly for writing CV and Cover Letters and to search for and apply for jobs. The youth who participated in the workshop stated that they have learned new risk about how they are using their devices or sharing information with other people online and this will help them act more carefully in the future.
