	So far we have ten workshops scheduled in Term 2 and two scheduled in Term 3. We are still liaising with eligible schools to finalise the dates for the remaining Term 3 workshops. This is in line with our projected timeline.
Achievements to date	First workshop was well received by students and teachers.
Difficulties to date	The project is running smoothly due to previous experience.
