InternetNZ is the home and guardian of .nz, providing the infrastructure, security and support to keep it humming. We help New Zealanders harness the power of the Internet through our community grants, research and policy. We are champions for an Internet that is accessible, open, and secure for all New Zealanders.

Purpose

The Security Operations Lead maintains situational awareness for security issues at InternetNZ group and provides advice to business owners on managing security risks. The security operations duties also include capability development and incident response. We are part of a small team in a diverse and important organisation.

Accountabilities

This position is responsible for:

Security Operations

- Maintain situational awareness of threats to information, personnel and physical assets
- Monitor assets for malicious activity or indicators of compromise
- Conduct analysis of suspicious incidents and initiate response as required
- Initiate and lead security incident response activities
- Ensure incidents are communicated and escalated as required
- Regular production of metrics or other reporting for security operations
- Maintain awareness of planned staff travel
- Analyse and recommend responses to changes in threat level
- Provide advice and support during the recruitment process
- Conduct auditing and alerting for physical breaches

Security Risk Management

- Threat Management
 - Identify and assess threats to InternetNZ
 - Monitor threat intelligence feeds for new indicators
- Vulnerability management
 - o Monitor for vulnerabilities identified in software or systems
 - o Identify vulnerabilities in our own systems and assets
 - Assess vulnerabilities as they are identified or change
 - Support system owners in remediation
- Risk Assessment
 - o Review risk management for existing and new systems
 - o Ensure risks have been correctly captured and expressed
 - Assess provided mitigations and report on suitability
- Mitigation advice
 - Support business owners to managing risks by advising on mitigations strategies and capabilities
 - o Provide advice for travel to international locations
 - o Provide physical security advice and guidance

Capability Development

- Help develop a strong security culture among InternetNZ staff, councillors and contractors
- Develop and deliver training to raise awareness and equip staff with security skills

- Develop exercises to test and enhance our capability to respond to and recover from a security incident
- Develop security related policies and procedures
- Management, administration & maintenance of technologies used by security operations
