The Internet NZ Grant has enabled us to build a website focusing on Deaf and disabled artists. The impact of this work is that Deaf and disabled artists will be visible in the wider arts sector. Deaf and disabled artists have a collective platform and a place to find support. Staff at Arts Access Aotearoa have a deeper understanding of building accessible websites.
