The 2018 AI x Cybersecurity Summit (ACSS2018, [acss.csmining.org](http://acss.csmining.org)) has been successfully held in Chongqing China this December.

We had distinguished speakers from New Zealand, China, USA, Japan, Australia, HongKong, and Sri Lanka. This includes academics from University of Illinois at Chicago, University of Tokyo, Chinese University of HongKong, Chongqing University, Victoria University of Wellington, Xi'an Jiaotong-Liverpool University, Wakayama University Japan, Federation University Australia, Sri Lanka Institute of Information Technology, and Unitec Institute of Technology New Zealand. The participations of industry are from Ctrip, Fujitsu, AnMa Tech, NICT, IFlyTek, and CERNET; and Venture Capitals from Glory Venture, Industrial Bank Co. LTD, and Shenzhen Venture Capital.

Through the IT Dean's forum at ACSS2018, we have made connections with almost all regional universities in Chongqing. The week, we were on the TV, newspapers, and ICT magazines of Chongqing. China major news medias including Toutiao, Tencent News, and Souhu News also reported our Summit.

ACSS2018 is proudly hosted by the International CyberSecurity Data-mining Society (ICSDS), where I am the Chair.
