What were the highlights and main takeaways of this conference?

0. In my experience, I gave my best presentation at this conference. People understood the idea of my research topic (which is happening not so often) and approaches I use. People asked many questions (usually no one asks) and even some of them discussed my approaches after the talk. This gave me satisfaction from the conference.

1. I met a lot of highly-experienced researchers from the networking field. It was helpful to compare their approaches in presenting results and mine. In addition to a well-constructed presentation, they tend to connect their results with everyday examples and make easy-to-understand demos. I will implement the demo approach in my future presentations.

2. Many of the participants have publications in A* conferences such as Infocom, Sigcom, Mobihoc, etc. It was worth to talk to them regarding their and my research areas. I hope at least I felt the thin edge between an ordinary publication and "the-star" publication.

3. The keynote speakers introduced new ideas regarding the future evolution of academia and industry. This was extremely helpful for me. For example, Professor J. J. Garcia-Luna-Aceves from the University of California told that fundamental research will always be in high demand. Professor Silvia Giordano from University of Applied Science and Arts shed light into privacy issues by giving good examples of how big influence can have a privacy breach in real life: US election, Brexit, Ukraine election, etc. This was the first talk which made me think and look at the privacy issues from a different point of view.

4. Beautiful spring weather in Warsaw and beautiful Warsaw impressed me a lot. I opened Poland again and now I am learning some historical fact about Poland.

What were the lowlights of the conference?

1. The main drawback of the conference was that the majority of the topics were focused on high-level communication and networking, while mine was concentrated on the physical level of communication. Thus, I did not have an opportunity to see others' research on the physical level.

2. The industry was not represented in the conference. I like when people from industry introduce their ongoing research. It gives a feeling of connection with real life.
